

## How to add the Color Incorporated image post to your TypePad blog

1. Log into your TypePad account at the following URL:  
<https://www.typepad.com/secure/services/signin?to=%2Fdashboard>
2. Click on the “Blog” button at the top middle of the page, and then select your blog from the drop-down menu.

3. Click on the “Library” button at the top of the screen, and then select the “TypeLists” option from the drop-down menu.

4. Select the “Add a TypeList” link. Match your settings to the image at right, and then click the “Create New Typelist” button.

5. A window much like the window pictured below should appear. Adjust the title to an appropriate value. Then, in the Notes section, you will need to

enter the image information. Go to the Color Inc blog setup web site (listed at the end of this step below the image). On that site, copy the HTML code from the box underneath the appropriate image. Paste this code into the “Notes” section on your window, as pictured at left. Finally, click the Save button at the bottom of the screen.

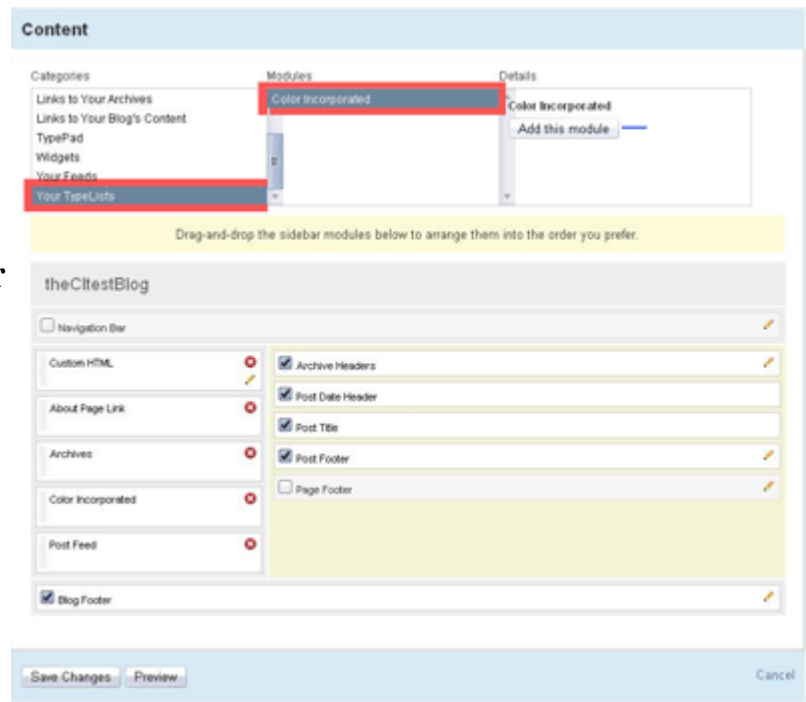

6. Next click the “Publish” tab at the top of the screen. Click the check box before the blog that you need to post this image on. Click “Save Changes.”

7. Now click the “Organize Content” link below the blog that you just posted this image on. This should bring up a new screen with a preview of your blog's layout, as seen below.

8. In the Categories section select “Your TypeLists”. Then in the Modules section select the name of the module you just created. Then, on the far right, click “Add this module.”

9. The module should appear in the sidebar preview below. Adjust this box to the necessary position, and then click the “Save Changes” button at the bottom.



10. Navigating to the blog should reveal the new Color Inc image ad placed in the appropriate place.
